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Photo Contest Rules

- Contest open to Amateur Photographers only
- Two classes per each category; A) Photo shopped or edited photos and B) non-edited photos (cropping is allowed)

PHOTO CONTEST CATEGORIES ARE:

- Sharing the Adventure
 - Seasons on the Trail
 - The Back Country
 - Work Projects
 - Equine
 - Kids
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- Chapters may enter up to six recent (last 24 months) photos not previously entered
 - Entries should be between 5x7 inches and 16x20 inches (panoramic images may be larger)
 - Entries must be single prints on photo quality paper; no collages, no nudity
 - Photos may be in color or black and white, not matted or framed
 - Photos to be submitted no later than 12 noon, March 23rd, 2019
 - Entrants wishing to submit a photo will provide the follow information to the Photo Contest Facilitator, at the registration table: Name, Address, Phone#, Chapter Name and Category. Upon providing this information, the entrant will receive a number to mark the back of each of their submitted photos with. This number will be later used to match the entrant to the photo.
 - Judging to be based on Photographic Society of America judging standards:
 1. Technical Quality: tonality, color, balance, image sharpness, exposure, blown out highlight, blocked out shadows
 2. Impact or Subject Interest: storytelling, mood, unusual lighting, emotional response, the “wow factor”
 3. Composition: balanced center of interest, subject in focus, foreground to background special relationships, simplicity
 - Ribbon Awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each category
 - Award for the “People’s Choice” of all the entries
